

## **GUIDELINES TO LESSON NOTES**

1. Each compilation has ten lessons.
2. Each lesson is for one hour, but can be adjusted to suit your time.
3. It's important to take note of things such as offering, praise and worship, birthdays, welcoming of 1<sup>st</sup> timers and visitors, etc. if you do them during your children services.
4. The first lesson is the general overview while the remaining nine lessons are based on specific aspects of the topic.
5. a) The *Central Truth* is the *Bible Truth* brought down to everyday talk.  
b) Remember KJV = King James Version, GNB = Good News Bible, NIV = New International Version Most of the memory verses are taken from the King James Version.  
c) You can reduce some of the memory verses for the younger children.  
d) If you don't know the song, or you have one you prefer, feel free to use the one you want.
6. There are three options for "Getting Started". Pick one or at most two of them to capture the interests of the students you are teaching before you go into the main work for the day.
7. The lessons contain worksheets that can be photocopied for each of the following four classes:
  - a) 2 – 4 years (Level 1)
  - b) 4 – 6 years (Level 2)
  - c) 7 – 9 years (Level 3)
  - d) 10 – 12 years (Level 4)
8. From time to time make an altar call for salvation, depending on the age. Some of them quickly make a decision for Christ and stick to it, some of them will take some time before the truth dawns on them. Ensure you give them assurance of salvation.

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
