CAR**

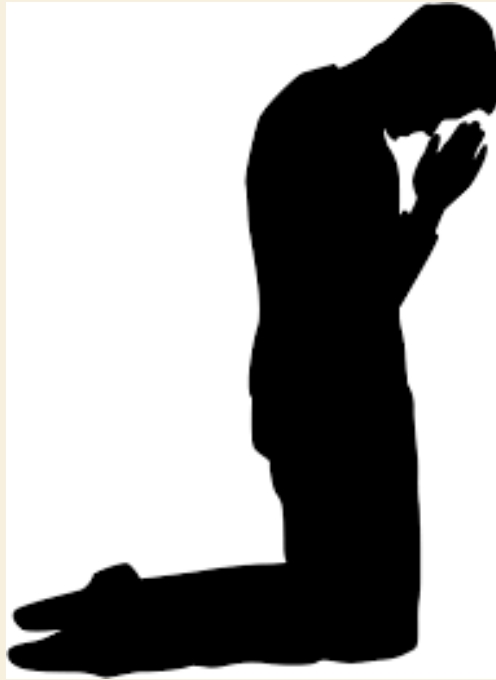


Several years ago, there lived a family of four, the Adebisi family.
