GETTING STARTED

- 1. The students should mention various types of emotions and they should give an example of a situation where someone would feel the emotion mentioned. OR
- 2. Tell a story of where there were two offenders and what happened when they apologized or not, and how they felt. OR
- 3. Using counters or cubes or any other suitable object place a certain number on one side and a different number on another side. The students should pick the side that has the higher number of objects. Do this a number of times and get different people to decide which side has more.

THE WORD

We all have different backgrounds. Some people lived morally upright lives until they got born again while other people were involved in various types of vices before they got born again. The former set of people when they get born again don't have much to change in their life styles. They know that their lives are now under the leadership of God and they try not to lead their lives as if it was their own. However, the latter set of people have many more things to change and they are usually more appreciative of the change that has taken place in their lives at the new birth.

Simon, a Pharisee, invited Jesus to his home and he was not happy with the woman who used her tears to wash Jesus' feet and her hair to dry the feet. She did some other things and Jesus told Simon that Simon had not given him water to wash his feet. It was customary for the host to give the visitor water to wash his feet, if a servant doesn't wash it for him. Simon as a Pharisee thought that he was close to God while the woman acknowledged that she was a sinner in need of Jesus to make a change in her life.

If you borrow ₹100 from someone, it's easier to return it than if you borrow ₹1,000. For example, if you could afford to return just ₹100 a week, in the first case you would pay the person back within a week. However in the second case it would take you ten weeks to pay it back. In that ten weeks of paying back the loan, you would have to forgo some things. Think about how you would feel in the first case and how you would feel in the second case.

Think about it. Who would be more grateful to the doctor, the person who had a small cut which was treated or the person who had appendicitis was operated on and the appendix which was inflamed was removed thus saving the person's life? Who would be more at peace, the person who was forgotten at school and given money to go home or the person who was forgotten at school and was driven home by his teacher or someone else in authority? Who would be more relieved, the person who mistakenly broke one plate and was forgiven or the person who mistakenly broke a dozen plates and was forgiven?

How would you feel if someone not related to you came and paid for a debt you owed? Or when your parents had said that they had no money for you to go on the excursion with your class mates and someone paid for you not wanting anything back? Or your parents saying that you have

to go to a cheaper school because they are owing your present school last term's school fees and then someone comes and pays for the school fees for that term and for the rest of your stay in that school?

At the end of it all, we are to know that God has forgiven us our sins. It is up to us to repent and accept his gift, his forgiveness.
